Hope: Pray for students/teachers to be prepared to share the hope of the Gospel. (*1 Peter 3:15*)

Opportunities: Pray for God to open many doors of opportunity for His word to go forth. (*Col. 4:3*)

Obedience: Pray for students/teachers to be obedient to Christ's "Great Commission". (*Matt. 28: 18-19*)

Love: Pray for students/teachers to show God's love to all. (*1 Thes. 3:12*)
