**The Head Start Kids' Pantry is an on-going project, and we hope to continue to support the children and families of Head Start**

- This program is voluntary, and families return a form indicating they are interested in participating. Upon receiving the form, children will receive a bag of food on a bi-weekly basis.
- We are currently serving 44 children in our community and more than 40 families. So far this school year, we have packed 176 bags of food.

You can support the program in the following ways:

1. Pray! for the families, for the children, and for open doors.
2. Monetary Donations: Let us do the shopping! If you'd like to support but would rather not shop, you can donate funds toward the Kid's Pantry. Please make checks payable to Calvary Community Church and write "KID'S PANTRY" in the memo line.
3. SHOP!: We Need people to shop for pantry items. Specific lists and quantities will be provided via a sign-Up. Shoppers will be reimbursed for purchases from the food pantry account. Please Let Sarah Roberts Know if you would be Interested in shopping.
4. Pack Bags: We will need a few people to help pack food bags and maintain the pantry. We will be packing on Wednesday evenings. If you are interested in helping with this, please contact Sarah Roberts.

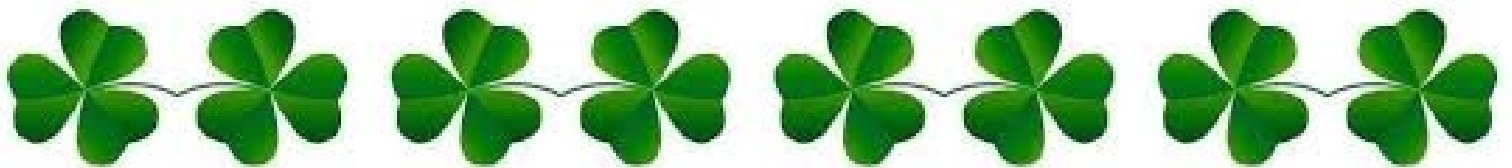
